ORDINANCE NO. 12,2010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2-2004 IN ITS ENTIRETY WHICH AMENDED ORDINANCE IS DESIGNED TO COMPLY WITH THE CLEAN WATER ACT (33 U.S.C. 1251), AND THE GENERAL PRETREATMENT REGULATIONS (40 CFR PART 403) WHICH ACT AND REGULATION SETS FORTH THE UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR USERS OF THE WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND PUBLICLY OWNED TREATMENT WORKS (POTW) AND SERVING AS ARTICLES 1 AND 2 OF RULES AND REGULATIONS REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, INDIANA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF SECTIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus, Indiana ("City"), owns and operates a municipal sewage works system ("Sewage Works"), by and through its Utility Service Board ("Board"), collecting and treating sewage waters from the City and its inhabitants and collecting rates and charges for such services pursuant to IC 8-1.5; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance sets forth uniform requirements for users of the wastewater collection and publicly owned treatment works (POTW) for the City of Columbus, Indiana and enables Columbus to comply will all applicable state and federal laws including The Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1251), and the General Pretreatment Regulations (40 CFR Part 403).

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that Article 1 and Article II of Ordinance No. 2, 2004 should be deleted and replaced.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, INDIANA that Article I and Article II of Ordinance No. 2, 2004 be deleted and replaced as follows:
